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## Eliot Weinberger

Eliot Weinberger (born 1949) is an American essayist, translator, and editor. Weinberger co-founded the literary magazine *Montemora* (1975-1982), and served as the primary literary translator for Octavio Paz and Beidao, in addition to translating work by Jorge Luis Borges, Vicente Huidobro, and others. Weinberger's writings span political commentary and literary criticism, and appear in books (many published by *New Directions*), the *London Review of Books*, the *New York Review of Books*, and elsewhere. He has edited a number of anthologies, including the *New Directions Anthology of Classical Chinese Poetry* (*New Directions*, New York, 2003).

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## Content Description
