Stephen O. Saxe

Stephen O. Saxe (1930-2019) was a graduate of Harvard College and Yale Drama School. His first career was as a set designer, working for summer stock and in television. He later worked as a book designer and graphic artist for Harcourt Brace. After retiring, Saxe devoted himself to the study of letterpress printing, and was a founding member of the American Printing History Association.

Content Description

This collection consists of set and costume designs by Stephen O. Saxe, photographs of theatrical set designs and performances, photographs of the Saxe family, and other papers including printed materials, and writings. Also includes a set design by Robert Edmond Jones.
