Edward M. Burns

Edward M. Burns (1944-) is a professor of English at William Paterson University. Burns has authored and edited numerous articles, critiques, and collections about Gertrude Stein and her contemporaries.

Gertrude Stein (1874-1946)

Gertrude Stein (1874-1946) was an American writer and supporter of the arts. She spent her adult life living and working in Paris, France with her life partner, Alice B. Toklas. A biographical timeline is provided in the register for the Gertrude Stein and Alice B. Toklas papers (YCAL MSS 76).

Alice B. Toklas (1877-1967)

Alice B. Toklas (1877-1967) lived and worked with her life partner, Gertrude Stein, in Paris, France. Alice and Gertrude were supporters of artists and literary figures of the early 20th century such as Pablo Picasso, Ernest Hemingway, and Henri Matisse. A biographical timeline is provided in the register for the Gertrude Stein and Alice B. Toklas papers (YCAL MSS 76).

Scope and Contents

The Edward M. Burns collection of Alice B. Toklas and Gertrude Stein papers contains correspondence, writings, print materials, photographs, artwork, audiovisual materials, realia, and other papers by, to, or relating to Alice B. Toklas and Gertrude Stein collected by Edward M. Burns spanning the years 1896 to 2020.

Series I, Correspondence, is divided into three sub-series: outgoing correspondence from Gertrude Stein and Alice B. Toklas, outgoing correspondence from others, and incoming correspondence. The outgoing correspondence from Gertrude Stein and Alice B. Toklas subseries contains primarily a series of letters from Alice B. Toklas to Louise and Redvers Taylor. Outgoing correspondence from others includes material from Thornton Wilder and Daniel-Henry Kahnweiler. Incoming correspondence pertains primarily to communications received by Edward M. Burns including persons such as Cecil Beaton, Robert Indiana, Daniel-Henry Kahnweiler, Michel Leiris, Sonia Orwell, Sir Francis Rose, Louise and Redvers Taylor, Isabel and Thornton Wilder, and others. This subseries also contains other third-party correspondence to Ulla Dydo, Edgar Allen Poe, and Thornton Wilder.

Series II, Writings, is arranged into two subseries: writings by Alice B. Toklas and Gertrude Stein, and writings by others. Writings by Alice B. Toklas and Gertrude Stein contains multiple editions of Steins work, and most notably, a commonplace book kept by Alice B. Toklas from 1896 to 1901. Writings by others contains published and unpublished material by individuals including Edward Burns, Leon Katz, Michel Leiris, Carl Van Vechten, and Isabel Wilder.

Series III, Artwork and ephemera, contains drawings, paintings, posters, and household items once owned by Alice B. Toklas, Gertrude Stein, and Carl Van Vechten. Among the visual artists represented in this series are Sir Francis Rose, Francisco Riba-Rovira, and Robert Indiana.

Series IV, Photographic prints, contains prints of Alice B. Toklas, Gertrude Stein, and other individuals including friends.

Series V, Publications, pamphlets, and other papers, includes print publications, playbills, catalogs, critiques, and clippings collected by Edward M. Burns.

Series VI, Audiovisual material, includes videocassettes, audiocassettes, and microcassettes relating to Gertrude Stein, Alice B. Toklas, and Isabel Wilder.

Series VII, Computer media, includes CDs and a DVD.
