Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

Various acquisitions associated with the collection have not been merged and organized as a whole. Each acquisition is described separately in the contents list below, identified by a unique call number and titled according to month and year of acquisition.

Information included in the Description of Papers note and Collection Contents section is drawn from information supplied with the collection and from an initial survey of the contents. Most folder titles appearing in the contents list below were transcribed from the recto or verso of the artwork. Otherwise, folder titles were supplied by staff during processing.

### Alexis de Tocqueville (1805-1859)

Alexis de Tocqueville was a French politician and author best known for Democracy in America (1835, 1840).

#### Scope and Contents

This finding aid encompasses accessions of single manuscripts and small groups of manuscripts and other papers, by or pertaining to French author and politician Alexis de Tocqueville, which the library has chosen to group and list as an artificial collection.

The collection primarily consists of letters from or to Tocqueville. Correspondents include John Quincy Adams, George Bancroft, Edward Everett, Léonard Faucher, Émile de Girardin, Michel Lévy, William H. Prescott, Jeanne Françoise Julie Adélaïde Bernard Récamier, Jean-Charles Rivet, Theodore Sedgwick, Jared Sparks, Charles Sumner, George Sumner, and others. Also included is a small amount of material related to Tocqueville's father Hervé de Tocqueville and brother Hippolyte des Tocqueville, and a letter book of British economist Nassau William Senior.
