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## Biographical / Historical

Irving Schlein (1905-1986) was an American composer of orchestral, chamber, instrumental, choral and operatic works. A lifelong New Yorker, he also enjoyed a 30-year career on Broadway as a musical director, pianist, arranger, and composer.

He held degrees in piano from New York College of Music ('28) and Juilliard School of music ('30) and was one of the last two living students of Franz Liszt. He later studied composition with Wallingford Riegger, Roger Sessions, Aaron Copland, and Roy Harris.

Many of Schlein's compositions reacted to events and American world history -- such as slavery, World War II, and the Holocaust -- as well as everyday life. He was known for his collaborations with Kurt Weill, and also worked with Al Jolson, Cole Porter, and Lerner and Lowe. Later in life, he taught music in the New York City school system, producing his vocal works, including the folk opera "Stackalee," with his students. He transcribed the 1867 A. L. Ware and Garrison collection of "Slave Songs of the United States." In 1968, he completed his full-length dramatic opera, "Salamambo." Schlein died in his native Manhattan in 1986 at the age of 80.
