Biographical / Historical

Rodney Harry Rackstraw Downes--realist painter and writer--was born in Pembury, Kent, England in 1939. Downes studied at the Hotckiss School in Connecticut from 1957-1958, received a Bachelor of Arts in English literature from Cambridge University, as well as a Bachelor of Fine Arts (1963) and a Master in Fine Arts in painting (1964) from Yale University. After finishing his studies, Downes remained in the United States and became a citizen in 1980.

Downes is most well-known for his artworks created in the plein-air style, particularly his painted landscapes and cityscapes of Maine, far West Texas, and New York City.

Downes's writings have been published in numerous publications including the New York Times, Art News, Art in America, and others. Over the course of his career, Downes has received a Guggenheim Fellowship, a MacArthur "Genius" Fellowship, and is a member of both the Academy of Arts and Letters and the National Academy of Design.

Scope and Contents

The collection contains correspondence, writings, notebooks, articles, essays, reviews, and talks, printed material, interviews, and exhibition catalogues, and other materials related to Rackstraw Downes life and work.

The collection is arranged in five series: Series I. Correpondence. Series II. Writings. Series III. Printed material. Series IV. Degrees and certificates. Series V. Travel.

Much of the of the donor's arrangement has been retained. Labeled page protectors from Downes' original binders have been copied and retained when possible.
