Restau Press

Restau Press was a short-lived literary press operated by J. Mark Nunnelee in the late 1960s and early 1970s. Nunnelee returned from the war in Vietnam and became a bookdealer and publisher for a brief period. His press published work from the eastern Massachusetts literary scene which resulted in a single issue of Restau: A Journal of Passage in 1970, a pamphlet by Stephen Jonas, and poetry broadsides by writers including Jonas, Gerrit Lansing, John Wieners, and Larry Eigner.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains writings, proofs, and correspondence relating to Restau Press, which published a single issue in 1970. Writings include submissions to Restau Press and poetry by contemporaries. Notable poets in this collection include John Wieners, Janine Pommy-Vega, Gerrit Lansing, and Jackson Mac Low. The Restau Press records included here contain drafts of *Restau: A Journal of Passage* and a corrected typescript of *Spring and Autumn Annals: A Celebration of the Season* by Diane di Prima.

Arrangement

This collection is organized into two series: I. Writings compiled by Michael Petree, 1954-1986. II. Restau Press, 1969-1972.

Series I: Writings compiled by Michael Petree, 1954–1986

This series contains writings compiled by Michael Petree, including submissions to Restau Press and poetry by contemporaries. Among the materials are an index of poems from "The Floating Bear", a newsletter created by Diane di Prima and Amiri Baraka in the early 1960s. Notable poets include John Weiners, Janine Pommy-Vega, Gerrit Lansing, and Jackson Mac Low.

The correspondence is a mix of personal and business sent to the editor of Restau, J. Mark Nunnelee, and includes letters from Stephen Jonas and Daniel Shaff.
