#### **ROBERT GIROUX (1914-2008)**

Robert Giroux was an American book editor and publisher. He was born April 8, 1914, in Jersey City, New Jersey. He attended Columbia University, before going on to work for Columbia Broadcasting Network, Harcourt Brace & Company, Farrar, Straus & Company (later Farrar, Straus & Giroux).

Giroux worked with many prominent authors including John Berryman, Elizabeth Bishop, T. S. Eliot, Robert Lowell, Thomas Merton, and others. Giroux also served as the president of the National Board of Review of Motion Pictures.

Robert Giroux died on September 5, 2008.

## **Content Description**

This collection contains correspondence to and from Robert Giroux, along with related correspondence between others; writings of authors such as T.S. Elliot, Robert Lowell, and Elizabeth Bishop, represented by Robert Giroux including typescripts, proofs, and galleys; photographs of Robert Giroux and others; and other papers relating to Giroux and publishing.
