Biographical / Historical

Brian McStotts (1957-2023) was a photographer who grew up surfing the beaches of Southern California. He captured the essence of surf culture in a his images taken during the 1970s-80s. Many of his photographs feature intricate details of surfers--riding the waves of Manhattan Beach and beyond--with the purpose of capturing the unique world of life on the ocean.

Content Description

The Western US surfing ephemera collection includes photographic prints taken by surfer and photographer Brian McStotts. These images of surfers were captured primarily off Manhattan Beach Pier, among other popular surfing spots.

The collection also contains correspondence, announcements, clippings, decals, and other printed material related to surfing competitions, film festivals, and other activities. Also included are mailers for events and competitions from the South Bay Longboard Association and the Dapper Dann Surfing Association, along with announcements from the Manhattan Beach Cultural Arts Committee and the Old Wave Surfing Association.

Arrangement

The collection is arranged into three series: I. Photographic prints, 1972-1986. II. Correspondence and clippings, 1979-1987. III. Flyers and other ephemera, 1982-1987.
