Susannah Colt is an author and former personal assistant to poet Maxine Kumin. As an assistant, Colt traveled with Kumin on speaking engagements, literary festivals, and talks from 2008-2014. Colt created a photo book "My Travels with Max" in 2014 to chronicle her time with Kumin. The correspondence Colt shares in this collection offers insight into the relationship of Colt and that of Maxine and her husband, Victor Kumin. Colt currently lives in New Hampshire.
