Biographical / Historical

Educational and medical work have been integral parts of the missionary movement and churches formed from that movement. Throughout the world, mission agencies and churches established schools, hospitals,

and centers for the treatment of individuals suffering from leprosy (Hansen's disease), mental illness, and blindness.

Scope and Contents

Much of this collection consists of printed or mimeographed reports, memos, brochures and other documentation of the work of the educational and medical institutions and organizations represented. This material came to the Divinity Library in various ways over the years. The documentation in this collection is not comprehensive but it provides useful background and detail about educational and medical work of mission agencies and the churches formed out of the mission movement, from its beginnings until the present time. The majority of the material in this collection dates from the 19th and 20th centuries.

Nanking Theological Seminary Board of Founders

The Board of Founders of Nanking Theological Seminary [Jinling shen xue yuan] was founded in 1937. The original charter of the Nanking Theological Seminary was amended in 1952 to expand the purposes of the organization to include support of theological education in China and other parts of Asia. In 1963 the name of the corporation was changed to the Foundation for Theological Education in South East Asia. See additional documentation in Yale Divinity Library Record Group 180.
