The largest correspondence files are from Corman and Griffiths, poet and curator of the Eric Mottram Archive at King's College, London. Griffiths's letters, for example, discuss literary matters, the literary scene in England, and life in northeastern England. Writings consist chiefly of drafts of poetry collections, but there are also novels, short stories, copies of Sherman's graduate student work at SUNY Buffalo, and offprints for articles by other writers. Other materials include audio and video recordings, computer disks, subject files, photographs, and printed materials.

William David Sherman (1940-2023)

William David Sherman, American author, educator, and publisher, was born December 24, 1940, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to Louis and Gertrude (Benn) Sherman. Sherman was educated at Temple University (B.A., 1962) and SUNY Buffalo (M.A., 1964, Ph.D., 1968), after which he taught as an instructor and lecturer at various institutions in the U.S and Great Britain over most of the next two decades before settling in French Polynesia. Sherman died in London on May 24, 2023.

Scope and Contents

Correspondence in the collection consists chiefly of incoming letters from English-language authors and literary scholars active during the mid to late twentieth century, including Asa Benveniste, Basil Bunting, Cid Corman, Robert Creeley, Rachel Blau DuPlessis, David Goodis, Bill Griffiths, Jeremy Hilton, Lyn Lifshin, Susan Smith Nash, Frances Presley, and Tom Raworth. The largest correspondence files are from Corman and Griffiths, poet and curator of the Eric Mottram Archive at King's College, London. Griffiths's letters, for example, discuss literary matters, the literary scene in England, and life in northeastern England. Writings consist chiefly of drafts of poetry collections, but there are also novels, short stories, copies of Sherman's graduate student work at SUNY Buffalo, and offprints for articles by other writers. Other materials include audio recordings, computer disks, subject files, photographs, and printed materials.

The 2005 Acquisition contains correspondence, writings, and other materials. Correspondence consists chiefly of incoming letters from English-language authors and literary scholars active during the mid to late twentieth century, including Asa Benveniste, Basil Bunting, Cid Corman, Robert Creeley, Rachel Blau DuPlessis, David Goodis, Bill Griffiths, Jeremy Hilton, Lyn Lifshin, Susan Smith Nash, Frances Presley, and Tom Raworth. The largest correspondence files are from Cid Corman and Bill Griffiths, poet and curator of the Eric Mottram Archive at King's College, London. Griffiths's letters, for example, discuss literary matters, the literary scene in England, and life in northeastern England. The correspondence also includes letters from friends and acquaintances in Moorea, French Polynesia, where Sherman resided in the early to mid 1990s.

The writings include corrected holograph drafts for poems, stories, and essays by Sherman, and several offprints for articles by other writers. Other materials include printed ephemera relating to Sherman and Shreela Ray.

The December 2007 Acquisition contains writings, correspondence, and other materials. Writings, arranged alphabetically by title, consist chiefly of drafts of poetry collections, but there are also novels, short stories, and copies of Sherman's graduate student work at SUNY Buffalo, including his thesis, "The Hero as Athlete" (1964), and dissertation, "The Contemporary American Novel" (1968).

In addition to writings, there are audiovisual materials, computer disks, correspondence and subject files, photographs, and printed materials. The audiovisual materials consist chiefly of audio recordings (on reel-to-reel and cassette tapes) of interviews, readings, and events, with Sherman and others. The computer disks contain drafts of writings, correspondence, and other materials, all in plain text files.
