SUMMARY: This collection consists primarily of correspondence with family members, missionary colleagues, and supporting churches, which provides documentation of the life and work of Laurence and Virginia Judd. The Judds were Presbyterian missionaries and fraternal workers in Thailand from 1948 to 1970. Laurence was associate director of the Rural Life Department of the Church of Christ in Thailand from 1961 to 1970. Virginia was involved in educational work and the Church of Christ in Thailand Music Committee.

1942-1944	○ LCJ secretary of youth work for New Haven Conference of Churches
1944-1946	○ LCJ pastor of Foxon Congregational Church, East Haven, CT
1945	○ LCJ and VMJ married; five children
1946	○ LCJ received B.D. from Yale Divinity School; VMJ also took courses at YDS and at Institute of Far Eastern Studies at Yale
1946-1947	○ LCJ assistant pastor of Chinese Presbyterian Church of San Francisco, under appt. by the Presbyterian Board of National Missions
1948	○ LCJ and VMJ arrived in Beijing, under appointment of the Presbyterian Board of Foreign Missions, but due to political situation they were transferred to Thailand in December 1948.
1948-1951	○ Taught at Bangkok Christian College
1951-1953	○ Administrative and evangelistic work in Pitsanuloke Province, Thailand
1954	○ LCJ received M.S. from Cornell University
1954-1959	○ Rural development work in Nan Province
1961	○ LCJ received Ph.D. from Cornell University
1961-1970	○ LCJ associate director of Rural Life Department of Church of Christ in Thailand. Department cooperated with government and private agencies serving rural people and assisted church districts and local congregations in developing church and community improvement projects. VMJ assisted in the department program, tutored English, and was active in musical activities in church schools, village churches, national conferences, and the Lampang community music club.

Scope and Contents
