**SUMMARY:** The papers consist of correspondence, writings, and personal papers which document the personal and professional life of Laura Stedman. The correspondence highlights personal and professional affiliations with Edmund Clarence Stedman (grandfather), Dr. George M. Gould (husband), and a number of writers including Martha Dickinson Bianchi, Ednah Proctor Clarke (Hayes), and Cora Miranda Baggerly Older. The papers include examples of Stedman's writing, publications, and a run of her scrapbook journals.

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## Processing Information

This collection includes materials previously identified by the call number Za Dies, having been mistakenly identified as the papers of Laura Woodworth Stedman Gould Dies. This identification reflected an erroneous spelling of the last name of Laura Stedman's second husband, the donor of the papers, Milton Seabury Dees. The collection also includes material previously separated and cataloged under Za Brower which has been reintegrated.

Most of the descriptive information used in the inventory of this finding aid was derived from folder notes and catalog cards created by previous staff members of the Beinecke library.

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## Biography

Laura Woodworth Stedman was born in 1881, the daughter of Frederick Stuart Stedman and Ellen Montague Douglas Stedman, and the granddaughter of banker, editor, and poet, Edmund Clarence Stedman. She was educated at private schools in New York City, including Arundell Academy and the Brackett School. Stedman served as literary secretary to her grandfather in the decade preceding his death in 1908 and, thereafter, as his literary executor. In 1908 Stedman contributed a bibliography to George M. Gould's *Concerning Lafcadio Hearn*. Working with Gould again, she edited a two-volume edition of her grandfather's letters, *Life and Letters of Edmund Clarence Stedman* (1910). In 1916 she published a short appreciation of Bayard Taylor in *The Mid-West Quarterly*. The following year Stedman and Gould married, taking up residence in Atlantic City, New Jersey. After Gould's death in 1922, Stedman remained in Atlantic City through 1930, in which census she is listed as a widow and an author. At the time of her death in 1939, Stedman was married to Milton Seabury Dees and resided in New York.

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## Scope and Contents

The papers consist of correspondence, writings, and personal papers that document the personal and professional life of Laura Stedman. The correspondence constitutes the larger part of the collection and highlights personal and professional affiliations with Edmund Clarence Stedman (grandfather), Dr. George M. Gould (husband), Ellen Douglas Stedman (mother), and a number of writers including Martha Dickinson Bianchi and Cora Miranda Baggerly Older. Of particular note is the correspondence group related to her work as literary agent for the writer Ednah Proctor Clarke (Hayes), which includes correspondence,

playscripts, and contractual agreements between a range of interested parties including the actress Khyva St. Albans and a number of theatrical producers. Writings include notes and a typescript for a play titled "The Conquering Flame," notes and correspondence related to the editing and publication of the letters and manuscripts of Edmund Clarence Stedman, and limited collected writings of other authors, including Mary S. Edgar. The personal papers include materials related to Stedman's education, including an early report card and school notebooks; a run of scrapbook journals containing notes, photographs, postcards, and clippings which document a range of interests; and collected visual materials including drawings attributed to Albert Bierstadt and Petrella da Bologna.

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## **Arrangement**

Organized into three series: I. Correspondence, 1887-1930; II. Writings, circa 1902-1928. III. Personal papers, 1888-1931.

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## Collection Contents

### Series I: Correspondence, 1887-1930

The series consists of incoming and outgoing correspondence of Laura Stedman. The General and Personal correspondence include similar material, but the Personal correspondence is comprised of more extensive exchanges with family and friends that were previously separated out by Stedman and library staff. Professional correspondence includes correspondence related to her work as a writer, editor, and literary agent as well as voluntary efforts related to World War I.

Correspondence is organized into three subseries: General, Personal, and Professional.

General and personal correspondence are arranged alphabetically by name; professional correspondence is arranged alphabetically by subject.
