## Harvey Shapiro (1924-)

Harvey Shapiro, an American poet, was born in Chicago, Illinois on 27 January 1924. He served in the U.S. Air Force from 1943 to 1945 and was educated at Yale University (BA, 1947) and Columbia University (MA, 1948). Shapiro taught briefly as an English instructor before embarking on a career as an editor, first with *Commentary* (1955-1956) and *The New Yorker* (1956-1957), and later with *The New York Times Magazine* (1957-1975, 1983-) and *The New York Times Book Review* (1975-1983). Shapiro's collections of poetry include *This World* (1971), *Lauds & Nightsounds* (1978), *The Light Holds* (1984), and *National Cold Storage Company* (1988). Shapiro married Edna Lewis Kaufman in 1953 and has two sons.

## Scope and Contents

The collection contains correspondence, writings, and personal papers documenting the personal and professional life of American poet and editor Harvey Shapiro. Correspondence consists chiefly of letters to Shapiro from American and English-language authors, literary critics, and editors who came of age in the post-WWII period, with the bulk of the letters dating from the 1950s through mid 1980s. There are files for Barbara Gibbs and Francis Golfing and for author and publisher Alan Swallow, but letters can also be found for Charles Bernstein, Allen Ginsberg, David Ignatow, Robert Lowell, George Oppen, and others. Many letters from writers are addressed to Shapiro in his capacity as editor of *The New York Times Magazine* or *The New York Times Book Review*. Letters from editors of other journals tend to concern his own literary submissions.

The Writings series contains writings by Shapiro, material relating to work by Shapiro, such as publicity and reviews, and writings by others. Shapiro's writings feature drafts for a number of poetry collections, including *Lauds & Nightsounds* (1978), *The Light Holds* (1984), *National Cold Storage Company* (1988), and

*This World* (1971), as well as shorter works. The writings by others may have been solicited by or submitted to Shapiro in his capacity as editor and separated from accompanying correspondence.

Personal papers include clippings and programs, financial and legal records, and a small number of photographs.

Series I. Correspondence consists chiefly of letters to Shapiro from American and English-language authors, literary critics, and editors who came of age in the post-WWII period, with the bulk of the letters dating from the 1950s through mid 1980s. There are larger files for Barbara Gibbs and Francis Golfing and for author and publisher Alan Swallow, but letters can also be found for Charles Bernstein, Allen Ginsberg, David Ignatow, Robert Lowell, George Oppen, and others. Many letters from writers are addressed to Shapiro in his capacity as editor of the *The New York Times Magazine* or *The New York Times Book Review* (1975-1983). Letters from editors of other journals, on the other hand, tend to concern his own literary submissions. The odd incoming letter is accompanied by an autograph manuscript note by Shapiro or a carbon reply. Enclosures, identified below in folder notes, include drafts of writings, third-party correspondence, photographs, and printed material.
