James Joseph Daly (1901-)

The poet and playwright James Joseph Daly was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and educated at the Carnegie Institute of Technology and at Harvard University, where he studied drama with George Pierce Baker and was a student in Baker's famous "47 Workshop" course. A member of the American Theater Laboratory, Daly occassionally acted in professional theaters and served as director of theaters in various parts of the country. Daly also worked as a copy-writer and editor for N. W. Ayer, Standard Oil Company of Ohio, and the WPA California. Works by Daly include *The Guilty Sun* (1926), *One Season Shattered* (1936), and *Poems: 1923-1943* (1943).

Series II. contains writings by Daly and others. The Plays subseries consists chiefly of theatrical scripts and work by Daly. Poems and Other Writings are essentially unsorted writings, with a mix of drafts of poems and other writings, including short essays, sketches, scenes of plays, reviews, notes, and school papers, as well as some correspondence and other material, such as printed ephemera and clippings.
