Processing Information

August Kleinzahler

August Kleinzahler (1949-) is an American poet. Born in New Jersey, Kleinzahler attended college at the University of Wisconsin–Madison and the University of Victoria on Vancouver Island, British Columbia. Kleinzahler has written over ten books of poetry, including *Sleeping It Off in Rapid City*, which won the 2008 National Book Critics Circle Award in Poetry and the 2008 Lannan Literary Award in Poetry. He has won other awards including a Guggenheim Fellowship in 1989 and the Griffin Poetry Prize in 2004.

Scope and Contents

The August Kleinzahler Papers, which span from 1970 to 2014, contain poetry and prose writings, correspondence, clippings, photographs, ephemera, printed material, and other documentation related to the life and work of August Kleinzahler.
