Biographical / Historical

Katherine Vaughn was born in Brooklyn, NY on January 31, 1888. She graduated from Packer Collegiate Institute and Vassar College. For several years she was on the staff of Pratt Institute in Brooklyn. From 1920 to 1948, she was associated with the YWCA, serving for eight years as general secretary in Guangzhou (Canton) and Shanghai, China. Later she was head of publications and booksales for the YWCA in New York. She joined the staff of Fifth Avenue Presbyterian Church in 1948 and worked there until her death.

Scope and Contents

Detailed correspondence provides valuable documentation of Vaughn's work with the YWCA in China. Her professional work, social life, and her observations of political events shed light on the life of a single woman missionary in China during the 1920s. Complementary documentation may be found in the YWCA of the U.S.A. Records in the Sophia Smith Collection at Smith College.
