Biographical / Historical

The Day family of Connecticut traces its American origins to Robert Day (1604-1648), who settled in Massachusetts in 1634 and shortly thereafter relocated in Connecticut. Several generations of family members, many of whom are represented in this collection, were educated at Yale University and later taught or held administrative positions there. Many family members chose a religious career, including Jeremiah Day (1737-1806), Jeremiah Day (1773-1867), Henry Noble Day (1808-1890), and Mills Day (1783-1812). Brief genealogical charts for the families of Jeremiah Day (1737-1806) and Thomas Day (1777-1855) are located here.

Scope and Contents

The Day family papers consist of correspondence, account books, diaries, journals, lectures, manuscripts, notes, sermons, and related papers of the Day family, 1767-1929. The personal lives, academic activities, and professional careers of several family members are documented, including Reverend Jeremiah Day (1737-1806), Reverend Jeremiah Day (1773-1867), Henry Noble Day (1808-1890), Mills Day (1783-1812), and others.

Collection Contents

Series I: Correspondence, 1759-1905

This series contains letters of Day family members, with the bulk of correspondence relating to Thomas Day. The letters are largely personal in nature, relating to family concerns, although Thomas Day's activities as secretary of state in Connecticut are noted. Thomas Day's six daughters exchanged letters from the 1830s to the 1860s. His son, Thomas Mills Day, wrote often from Europe and the Middle East during 1850-1851.

The earliest letters in the collection appear to be written to and by Reverend Jeremiah Day (1737-1806), a minister in New Preston, Connecticut, and the letters relate to religious topics and include items exchanged with Jonathan Edwards (the younger).

Series II: Jeremiah Day (1737-1806)

This series contains an estate inventory, journals, poems, sermons, and theological papers written by Reverend Jeremiah Day from 1759-1804, and includes other family papers from later dates. Jeremiah Day's sermons date from 1759-1804, and his theological papers include student papers written at Yale University in the 1750s.

Series III: Jeremiah Day (1773-1867)

This series consists of account books, diaries, journals, lecture notebooks, manuscripts of books, sermons, and other papers of Reverend Jeremiah Day dating from 1797-1838. Papers relating directly to Day's service as president of Yale are arranged in Series VIII. Jeremiah Day, (1773-1867): Presidential Papers, 1805-1860.

Diaries contain information on the years 1797-1801 and journals focus on the years 1799-1802, with information through 1845. Lecture notebooks and outlines contain Day's thoughts on the subject "Natural Philosophy," while manuscripts for books such as *An Introduction to Algebra..., The Mathematical Principles..., Treatise of Plane Trigonometry, Edwards on the Will, Self Determining Power of the Will,* and others are included in this series. Sermons prepared and delivered by Reverend Day from 1799-1838 are also arranged here.
