Biographical / Historical

Robin William Evert Winks was born in Indiana on December 5, 1930. He graduated from the University of Colorado in 1952 and received an M.A. in Maori studies from Victoria University as a Fulbright Scholar in New Zealand. He received his Ph.D. from Johns Hopkins in 1957. Winks joined Yale's history department in 1957, serving as its chairman from 1996 to 1999. From 1999 to 2000, he was the Vyvyan Harmsworth visiting professor of American history at Oxford University. He was a prolific author and in 1987 published *Cloak & Gown: Scholars in America's Secret War*, an account of the Central Intelligence Agency's relationship with major American universities. Winks died in New Haven, Connecticut, on April 7, 2003.

Accession 2004-M-060: Additional Material, 1835-1998

This accession contains Winks's professional correspondence from his time as a professor, student work, teaching files, conference presentations, and research files. The bulk of the accession consists of drafts, research, and notes for Winks's book, *Cloak and Gown: Scholars in America's Secret War*, which explored the relationship between universities, particularly Yale, and the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) and its predecessor, the Office of Strategic Services (OSS). Also included are Winks's undergraduate papers; his teaching files from his time as a professor at Yale; papers written by Yale students in Winks's classes; and research materials for Winks's unpublished biography of William Francis Drummond. The research materials for the unpublished Drummond biography consist primarily of reproductions of documents that Winks used in his research.

Box 1 contains Yale University personnel files and is restricted until January 1, 2072.

The bulk of material in this grouping consists of photocopies and duplications of primary source documents, and dates reflect the dates of the original documents, not of the photocopies.
