After graduating from Cass Technical High School in Detroit in 1951, he earned a Bachelor of Science (1958) and Masters of Urban Planning (1968) from Michigan State University. From 1964 to 1965, Johnson was city planner for the New Haven, Connecticut, City Plan Commission.
