Biographical / Historical

Nan Swid and Addie Powell formed Swid Powell, a housewares firm, in 1982. They commissioned many of the most prominent architects of the day, including Richard Meier, Charles Gwathmey, Robert A. M. Stern, Michael Graves, Robert Venturi and Denise Scott Brown, and Stanley Tigerman, to design tableware for mass production. Many of these iconic pieces and their prototypes are held by major museums and design collections, including the Yale University Art Gallery. The firm ceased production in the mid-1990s.
