Biographical / Historical

Harold C. Conklin (1926-2016) received his BA degree from the University of California, Berkeley, in 1950 and his PhD from Yale University in 1955. He taught anthropology at Columbia University from 1954 until 1962, at which time he joined the Yale faculty. Conklin served as chair of the Department of Anthropology, curator of Anthropology, and director of Graduate Studies, as well as director of the Division of Anthropology at the Peabody Museum of Natural History. An emeritus professor, he retired from Yale in 1996. He was also the Frank Muzzy Crosby Professor Emeritus of the Human Environment. Conklin pioneered research in the field of ethnoscience, a discipline dealing with the way in which inhabitants of a particular area understand and treat their environment. His research focused primarily on ecology, ethnology, and linguistics in Southeast Asia, particularly the Philippines, and he authored numerous publications and articles in his field. Conklin died on February 18, 2016.

Scope and Contents

The papers comprise personal and professional correspondence, maps, and topical files, documenting the research of Conklin and his colleagues, particularly in the area of language in the Philippines. Maps were created in part by the American Geographical Society and the Army Map Service. The Topical Files include professional events and organizations in which Conklin participated; research materials

of colleagues Leonard Bloomfield, Frederick Russell Eggan, and Robert B. Fox; and materials relating to the Tasaday Controversy, in which the Tasaday, an indigenous people of Mindanao, a Philippine island, were considered in the 1970s-1980s to be the last vestiges of a stone age culture. Anthropologists and journalists questioned the validity of this claim. Additional files document Conklin's professorial, curatorial, and administrative activities at Yale, particularly in the Department of Anthropology and the Peabody Museum of Natural History.

The collection is arranged in three series and two additions: I. Correspondence, 1944-2005. II. Maps, 1908-1977. III. Topical Files, 1897-1998.

Accession 2016-M-0089: Additional materials, 1887-2016

This accession comprises Yale University administrative and teaching files, topical files, professional service files, and correspondence documenting Harold Conklin's professional responsibilities at Yale University and in professional organizations. The Yale University files document Harold Conklin's tenure at Yale University, including trips with the Association of Yale Alumni, teaching and research records from the Anthropology and Linguistics departments, and curatorial files from the Peabody Museum of Natural History. The records also document Conklin's professorial and administrative responsibilities at Yale, particularly in the Department of Anthropology, such as his chair and committee service, courses and exhibitions, the Agrarian Studies Program, Southeast Asia Studies activities, and the development of Human Relations Area Files. Those activities are represented through memoranda, meeting minutes, course and student files, personnel and financial records, event ephemera, and exhibition planning.

Topical files contain field research, correspondence, and biographical materials of Conklin's colleagues and students, including Patricia O. Afable, Richard F. Barton, Arthur Einhorn, Michiko Takaki, and Owen A. Tomlinson. Files on Floyd G. Lounsbury, William H. Scott, and William C. Sturtevant were compiled by Harold Conklin to write their obituaries.

Professional service files include records of conference activities, presentations, and projects in which Conklin participated.

Correspondence documenting Conklin's professional activities and communications with colleagues is present throughout the accession and is also included in the correspondence grouping.

Manuscripts and Archives staff grouped material on similar subjects together during processing to facilitate access by researchers. Folders without titles and loose papers were titled during processing.

The accession is arranged in four groupings: Yale University, Topical files, Professional service files, and Correspondence.

Yale University

This grouping includes files documenting Harold Conklin's tenure at Yale University as a professor in the Department of Anthropology and as Curator of Anthropology for the Peabody Museum of Natural History. Materials include research on the history of the Department of Anthropology, Conklin's teaching files, meeting minutes, and notes from councils and study groups in which Conklin participated.

Files are arranged by subject in alphabetical order. Additional materials related to the Peabody Museum are also in the Professional service grouping.

The bulk of the materials is open for research. Yale University student, personnel, and administrative records are restricted as established by Yale Corporation regulations <http://web.library.yale.edu/mssa/collections/research-use-of-yale-university-archives>. Any restricted records are noted as such.

Topical files

This grouping includes topical files Conklin maintained on his colleagues and students. Materials on Patricia O. Afable and Michiko Takaki, doctoral students who completed dissertations under Conklin, include personal and professional correspondence, field research notes, recommendation letters, writings, events, and advising on anthropological research. The Richard F. Barton files document Conklin's research on him and include Barton's original correspondence and records documenting projects and grants for his linguistic and film work in the Philippines. These files also contain Barton family correspondence and Barton's personal correspondence detailing his experience as a prisoner in the Philippines during World War I and transition back to the United States. Similarly, the Owen A. Tomlinson files include letters Tomlinson wrote to family, as well as photographs Tomlinson took while he was an officer in the Philippine Constabulary, Ifugao, Mountain Province. The Arthur Einhorn materials primarily include incoming and outgoing correspondence by Einhorn regarding anthropology topics.

Materials related to Floyd G. Lounsbury (Conklin's dissertation advisor at Yale University), William H. Scott, and William C. Sturtevant were collected by Conklin to write about their contributions to the field of anthropology for their obituaries. The materials contain writings and presentations by each individual, biographical notes by Conklin, correspondence, and printed material.
