Biographical / Historical

Atwell Loomis Bohling was born in 1922. He attended Smith-Cotton High School in Sedalia, Mo. He attended Yale from September 1941 to February 1943 and from July 1946 until he received his B.A. in August 1947. He served in the Army during his hiatus from Yale, and he was discharged as sergeant in 1946. He was a government major and member of Calhoun. Bohling was also a graduate student from 1947-1948. He was a staff member with the *Kansas City Star*. He was a reporter until July, 1950 and then a copy editor and headline writer afterwards. He also was chairman of the board of Jared Eliot Associates.

Scope and Contents

The Atwell Loomis Bohling Collection consists of signed/autographed correspondence, printed material, and photographs of government figures such as Woodrow Wilson, Harry S. Truman, Dwight D. Eisenhower, and their associates.
