Immediate Source of Acquisition

The Yale Bookplate Collection was formerly housed in Sterling Memorial Library. The collection was incorporated into the Arts of the Book Collection in 1984 and then moved to the Seeley G. Mudd Library in 1990. In 2011, it was transferred to the Robert B. Haas Family Arts Library.

Scope and Contents

The collection contains bookplates of various religious orders in the Christian tradition. Dating from the 16th to the 18th century, many of the bookplates represent Catholic communities or organizations in Germany.

Arrangement

Organized into three series: I. Bookplates – Religious Orders. II. Bookplates – Cities. III. Bookplates – Unidentified.

The original filing system grouped materials either by religious order or by the location of specific communities and organizations. Because of the small size of this collection, this original system has been maintained and is reflected in the series divisions. Within each series, folders are arranged alphabetically.

This series contains bookplates arranged by religious order. The various orders are arranged alphabetically.
