Biographical / Historical

Born in Pietermaritzburg, South Africa, Loram was educated at the University of the Cape of Good Hope (B.A. 1900), and the University of Cambridge (B.A. and LL.B. 1905, M.A. 1908), and Columbia University (Ph.D. 1917). In Africa, Loram held a number of government positions in education. Beginning as a teacher at Pietermaritzburg College, he was inspector of schools in Natal (1906-1917), Chief Inspector of Native Education (1917-1920), a member of the Union of South Africa Native Affairs Commission (1920-1929), Chief Inspector of Education, Natal (1929-1930), and Superintendent of Education (1930-1931).

In 1931, Charles Loram was appointed Sterling Professor of Education at Yale University, holding the position until his death in 1940. He also served as chairman and director of studies in the department of culture contacts and race relations in the Yale Graduate School from 1933. Other positions and honors held by Loram include: member of the Phelps-Stokes commission to Africa, 1922, to East Africa, 1925; trustee of Yale-in-China, recipient of honorary M.A. Yale University, 1931, recipient of honorary ED.D. University of Colorado, 1937; and participant in many seminars and conferences on the American Indian, Negroes, Africans, and Pacific Islanders. He was the author of *The Education of the South African Native*, 1919.

Scope and Contents

The Charles Templeman Loram (1879-1940) Papers document the life work of an internationally famous educator and professor of education in South Africa and at Yale. Most of the seventeen box collection consists of the writings of Professor Loram, his students and his colleagues on a wide variety of topics within the general fields of education, anthropology, religion, and race relations. Over three boxes in the papers consist of notebooks and notes compiled at the University of Cambridge.

Arranged in six series and one addition: I. Correspondence. II. Writings. III. Government Records. IV. Miscellaneous. V. Maps. VI. Pictures.

Collection Contents

Series I: Correspondence, 1932, 1934-1940

Correspondence includes letters, minutes, reports, and lists of publications. Folders are arranged alphabetically by name of individuals or institutions. Within each folder the material is then arranged chronologically. The correspondence is primarily with religious organizations, including Berkeley Divinity School, Hartford Seminary Foundation, Madison Avenue Presbyterian Church, the World Sunday School Association, and several groups in China and the Pacific. Also included is information on the Phelps-Stokes Fund.

Series II: Writings, 1902-1940

Writings include articles, reports, memoranda, book reviews, addresses, speeches, lectures, course and seminar outlines, college notebooks and notes, material from Boulder Seminar (1937), other people's writings, and theses written under Loram's supervision. Loram's articles, reports, speeches, lectures, course outlines and notes are arranged alphabetically by title. Loram's reviews and other people's writings are in alphabetical sequence by author's name.

The writings relate to Christian missionary work, underprivileged people in foreign nations and the United States, race relations, educational systems, anthropological studies of various cultures and South Africa. The college notebooks and notes cover courses in language, psychology, history and law at Kings College, Cambridge University. The material from the Boulder Conference in July, 1947, concerns the American Indian.
