The Yale Bookplate Collection was formerly housed in Sterling Memorial Library. The collection was incorporated into the Arts of the Book Collection in 1984 and then moved to the Seeley G. Mudd Library in 1990. In 2011 it was transferred to the Robert B. Haas Family Arts Library.

Scope and Contents

The collection consists of both private and institutional bookplates from Denmark as well as ephemeral materials related to the collection.

Arrangement

Organized into three series and one addition: I. Bookplates - Individuals. II. Bookplates - Organizations, Institutions, and Businesses. III. Bookplates - Artists; 2015 Addition.

The arrangement preserves the original alphabetical ordering by which special letters and those with diacritical marks were sorted at the end of the alphabet. Any correspondence or ephemeral materials relating to a specific bookplate are filed together with the bookplate.

2015 Addition

The series includes ex-libris designed by Friedrich (Frederik) Britze (1870-1956), a German-Danish engraver and printmaker. He was the father of Johannes Britze (1895-1960), who was also a bookplate artist, engraver, and painter.

The series also includes historical examples of Danish bookplates, bookplates of Danish royalty, and other ephemera.

Organized into three subseries: Friedrich (Frederik) Britze, Johannes Britze, and Miscellaneous.
