TLS is an abbreviation for "typed letter signed," and ALS is an abbreviation for "autographed letter signed."

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## **Scope and Contents**

The collection contains just over 50 letters, both typed and handwritten, between Carlyle S. Baer, secretary of the American Society of Bookplate Collectors and Designers, and Dr. Samuel X. Radbill, a pediatrician, medical historian, and collector of books and bookplates. Most letters are authored by Baer on Society letterhead, although the collection includes a few letters from Radbill as well. Subjects include Society business, such as yearbooks, membership dues, etc.; bookplate collecting and trading; Radbill's research and scholarship on medical ex-libris; and general bookplate news and trends.
