Biographical / Historical

John Flourney Montgomery (1878-1954) of Missouri was an American businessman and diplomat. He built a career in the dairy industry, specifically in the processing of condensed milk. From 1925 to 1933, he was the president of the International Milk Company in Vermont. Due to his support of the Democratic Party, he was given the diplomatic posting of United States Minister to Hungary from 1933 to 1941.

John Montgomery was married to Hedwig Wildi Montgomery (1881-1953), with whom he had two daughters: Marie-Louise Montgomery Osborn (1905-1968) and Jean Montgomery Riddell (1910-2010).

Scope and Contents

Correspondence to and from John Flourney Montgomery while he was United States Ambassador to Hungary, 1933-1939. The letters are bound in ten volumes and are arranged both chronologically and alphabetically.
