Please note that the original alphabetical ordering includes some variation in the treatment of surnames with prefixes; some names are entered under the part of the name following the prefix, whereas others are entered under the prefix itself. One may need to consult multiple folders in order to determine holdings. Any correspondence or ephemeral materials relating to a specific bookplate are filed together with the bookplate.
