## Biographical / Historical

Barbara Wertheim Tuchman was born in 1912, and received her B.A. degree from Radcliffe College in 1933. She served as a research assistant for the Institute for Pacific Relations, 1934-1935; was an editorial assistant at *The Nation*, 1936-1937; a staff writer for *War in Spain*, London, 1937-1938; American correspondent for *New Statesman* and *Nation*, London, 1939; and was with the Far East news desk, OWI, 1944-1945. Tuchman was best known as the author of many books and articles. She was the recipient of the Pulitzer Prize in 1963 and 1972. Tuchman died in 1989.

## Scope and Contents

The papers consist of correspondence, articles, speeches, printed material, research materials, photographs, and drafts of books relating to Barbara Tuchman's literary career, including such works as *Bible and Sword*, *The Zimmermann Telegram*, *The Guns of August*, and *The Proud Tower*.

### Series I: Personal, 1920, 1932-1933, 1935-1940, 1956, 1958-1959, 1962-1968

Personal materials contain correspondence, documents, printed material, reprints, lists, phonograph records, newspaper clippings and handwritten drafts. Included in this series are biographical information, letters of rejection from publishers, information about Mrs. Tuchman's service on various committees, honorary degrees, early writings from childhood and college, a scrapbook of clippings of her early journalistic work, a phonograph record of an interview with Mrs. Tuchman and miscellaneous lists and reprints.

**Series II: Writings, 1953-1969**

9.5 linear feet (24 Boxes, 4 Folios, 6 Card file boxes)

The material contained in this series includes books, articles, a broadcast, letters to the editor, a poem, reviews, and speeches.

The books include *Bible & Sword*, *The Zimmermann Telegram*, *The Guns of August*, and *The Proud Tower*. They are arranged alphabetically by title. Included within each unit are the correspondence, research materials, various drafts, and illustrations, pertinent to the various works.

The articles and speeches are basically arranged chronologically, as are the letters to the editor. These writings cover such topics as historical events, current affairs and historiography. A fairly substantial section of the writings pertains to Israel.

The reviews deal with *Thomas Woodrow Wilson* by William C. Bullitt and Sigmund Freud, *Ludendorff* by D.J. Goodspeed, *Justice in Jerusalem* by Gideon Hausner, *The Fall of Paris* by Alistair Horne, *Dare Call It Treason* by Richard M. Watt, and *Hitler's Spies and Saboteurs* by Charles Wighton and Gunter Peis. The reviews are arranged alphabetically by the name of the author of the book.
