Biographical / Historical

Born Irene Greene Dwen, Mrs. Pace (1892-1962) was an avid bookplate collector from the early 1920s until 1962. In addition to over 150,000 plates in her collection, she also maintained a reference library related to bookplates, as well as heraldry and biographical research. Pace commissioned several hundred bookplates for herself. In 1936, she published *Owners of Books: The Dissipations of a Collector*.

Scope and Contents

The collection consists of bookplates by Japanese artists, for Japanese patrons, or both. Individual and institutional patrons are represented.

Arrangement

Organized into four series: I. Bookplates – Individuals. II. Bookplates – Institutions. III. Bookplates – Unidentified. IV. Ephemera.

This series includes bookplates arranged by patron or artist. Some items have the patron's name but are missing the bookplate.
