## **Processing Information**

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

The collection received preliminary processing at the time of acquisition. Further rehousing, and description were carried out in 2014.

The collection is comprised of material formerly classed as Uncat MSS 91.

Information included in the Description of Papers note and Collection Contents section is drawn from information supplied with the collection and from an initial survey of the contents. Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases. Otherwise, folder titles are supplied by staff during basic processing.

#### **Stéphane Prince**

Stéphane Prince was a French writer, and personal secretary to the actor, playwright, and theater and film director Sacha Guitry from 1951 to 1957.

#### **Scope and Contents**

The material consists of manuscripts, typescripts, notes, date books, journals, financial records, and correspondence and subject files dating from the 1940s through the 1970s, which document Prince's preparation of his publications *Sacha Guitry hors sa légende* (1959), *L'Esprit français* (1961), and various unpublished essays, plays, poetry and other writings on Sacha Guitry and other subjects.
