Biographical / Historical

By the end of the nineteenth century, the Jewish population of Iasi had grown to nearly 40,000 people. The papers in this collection document the variety and cultural richness of the Jewish community, as well as responses to anti-Semitism during the twentieth century. In 1941, almost 14,000 thousand Jews in Iasi —nearly a third of the Jewish population--were massacred in a pogrom and subsequent deportations in death trains.

Scope and Contents

The collection consists of documents from the large Jewish community of Iasi, Romania, 1862-1950. About half of the documents in this collection pertain to Jewish communal life in Iasi in the late nineteenth and early twentieth century, while the rest date from the time of World War II or the postwar period. The first part of the collection contains approximately 100 documents in Romanian. The second part contains 19 documents in Yiddish.
