SUMMARY: The Christian Melchior-Bonnet Papers contain literary correspondence and writings of authors associated with Melchior-Bonnet. Most correspondence consists of letters to Melchior-Bonnet concerning his editorial work for *Le Petit Journal* and *Flammarion*; some is accompanied by outgoing carbons, or related memoranda and notes by Melchior-Bonnet, photographs, clippings, or other printed material. Correspondents include Paul Morand, represented by more than 200 letters, 1923-1976; other major correspondents are Pierre Champion, Roland Dorgelès, Marie Jeanne Durry, Jean-Jacques Gautier, Jean Giono, Victor Giraud, Emile Henriot, François Porché, and Jules Romains. Autograph manuscript writings include Morand's draft revision of *Le voyage* (Paris: Hachette, 1964); unidentified manuscripts by Henry Montherlant about his play *Pasiphaë* and essay collection *Mors et vita*; and other writings by Morand, Montherlant, Henry Bidou, Francis de Croisset, Victor Duruy, and others.

Processing Information

Former call numbers: Uncat MSS 428 and Uncat MS Vault File. In 2014, the collection received a baseline level of processing, including rehousing and minimal organization. The collection was reclassified under one call number, and containers were renumbered. Most folder titles were based on information provided by the vendor, while some were assigned by Library staff. Folder titles were not verified against contents.

Christian Melchior-Bonnet (1902-1995)

Christian Melchior-Bonnet, French journalist, editor, and author. Melchior-Bonnet was an editor of *Le Petit Journal*, *Historia*, and *Journal de la France*, and for the publisher Flammarion.

Scope and Contents

The Christian Melchior-Bonnet Papers contain literary correspondence and writings of authors associated with Melchior-Bonnet. Most correspondence consists of letters to Melchior-Bonnet concerning his editorial work for *Le Petit Journal* and Flammarion; some is accompanied by outgoing carbons, or related memoranda and notes by Melchior-Bonnet, photographs, clippings, or other printed material. Correspondents include Paul Morand, represented by more than 200 letters, 1923-1976; other major correspondents are Pierre Champion, Roland Dorgelès, Marie Jeanne Durry, Jean-Jacques Gautier, Jean Giono, Victor Giraud, Emile Henriot, François Porché, and Jules Romains. Autograph manuscript writings include Morand's draft revision of *Le voyage* (Paris: Hachette, 1964); unidentified manuscripts by Henry Montherlant about his play *Pasiphaë* and essay collection *Mors et vita*; and other writings by Morand, Montherlant, Henry Bidou, Francis de Croisset, Victor Duruy, and others.
