Nearly two-thirds of the women represented in the collection worked in the United States of America. Of the American photographers, nearly a quarter worked in Illinois or New York. Significant numbers worked in Iowa, Michigan, and Ohio. Women photographers from England and Sweden are also well-represented in the collection. Other represented nations and localities include Algeria, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Denmark, Egypt, Finland, France, Tahiti, Germany, Ireland, Japan, Malta, Norway, Scotland, Spain, Switzerland, and Wales.

Julia Driver is a collector of photography. She is also a philosopher with research interests in normative ethical theory and moral psychology. Her works include *Uneasy Virtue* (2001) and *Ethics: The Fundamentals* (2005).

Scope and Contents

This series consists of daguerreotypes and ambrotypes primarily in contemporary glass mats and decorative cases that document the work of women photographers and their partnerships. If known, each entry in this guide includes the life dates of the photographer, the locations active, work dates, and known aliases.

Series II: Card Photographs and Other Photographic Materials, 1845-1940

5.83 linear feet

This series consists of photographic materials, chiefly card photographs in the form of cartes-de-visite and cabinet photographs, as well as some variant styles of card photographs and other photographic print formats. There are also some scattered items of ephemera and printed material. The series documents work by over five hundred women photographers or their partnerships from the middle of the nineteenth century to the turn of the twentieth century. Only the work of Minnie F. Libby is referenced in multiple subseries.

The subjects for the majority of images are not documented in this series. However, descriptions include names of identified individuals, as well as notes concerning unique subject matter. Subjects include wedding portraits, studio portrait that include animals, exterior views, and portraits of children dressed for baptisms and confirmations.

Series I is organized into three subseries: Photographic Materials; Photographic Materials by Men; and Oversize Photographic Materials

Photographic Materials

This subseries consists of vintage photographic prints, chiefly cartes-de-visite and cabinet photographs, but also including some other card photographs, tintypes, and ephemera. Photographic materials with dimensions larger than 22 x 29 cm (8.7 x 11.4 in.) are located in the Oversize Photographic Materials subseries
