Dorothy Porter Wesley (1905-1995)

Dorothy Burnett Porter Wesley (1905-1995) librarian, curator and bibliophile, was born on May 25, 1905 in Warrenton, Virginia to physician Hayes Joseph Burnett and tennis player Roberta ("Bertha") Ball Burnett. Wesley, the eldest of four children, grew up in Montclair, New Jersey. She graduated from Miner Normal School, Washington D.C. in 1925 with the intention of becoming a teacher. Wesley worked as a library assistant in the Miner Normal School library where she worked with librarian Lula V. Allan who encouraged her to pursue a career in library science. Wesley enrolled in Howard University in 1926 and received a BA in 1928. After graduation from Howard University in 1928, Wesley began work as a full-time librarian at Howard University. In 1928 Wesley enrolled at Columbia University's School of Library Science where Wesley received a Master's in Library Science in 1931. In 1930, Wesley began work as curator of the Moorland Foundation, now known as the Moorland-Spingarn Research Center, at Howard University and worked to build collections documenting the African diaspora until her retirement in 1973. Under Wesley's administration, the Moorland-Spingarn Research Center became a world-renowned institution for the history and culture of people of African descent. After retirement, Wesley worked as a consultant for Radcliffe University's Black Women Oral History Archive and authored several articles, and books pertaining to librarianship and the African diaspora. Books authored by Dorothy Porter Wesley include *Early Negro Writing, 1760-1837* (1971), and *Afro-Braziliana: A Working Bibliography* (1978). Wesley married artist and art history professor James Amos Porter (1905-1970) and had a daughter, Constance Porter Uzelac (1939-2012). After James Porter's death in 1970, she married former Wilberforce University president and African American historian, Charles Harris Wesley in 1979. Dorothy worked with Charles on a variety of projects including research for a bibliography on abolitionist William Cooper Nell until Charles's death in 1987. *William Cooper Nell, Nineteenth-Century African American Abolitionist, Historian, Integrationist: Selected Writings 1832-1874* (2002) was later published by Constance Porter Uzelac in 2001. Dorothy Porter Wesley died in Broward County, Florida in 1995.

Scope and Contents

The collection consists chiefly of the correspondence, writings, biographical materials, research files, photographs, and personal papers of librarian, curator and bibliophile Dorothy Porter Wesley. The bulk of the collection is comprised of research materials relating to various subjects relating to African American history, culture, and bibliography, including the following: African-American abolitionists Sarah Remond and William C. Nell, African American literature, African literature, and Afro-Brazilian literature. The collection also includes records of the Association for the Study of Afro-American Life and History.

This collection is organized into four series: Series I. Correspondence, 1870-2011. Series II. Professional Papers, 1869-2003. Series III. Research Files, 1847-2004. Series IV. Personal Papers, 1869-2006.

Collection Contents

Series I: Correspondence, 1870–2011

Correspondence consists of letters to and from or indirectly received by Dorothy Porter Wesley and her family. The series documents Wesley's professional and personal activities as librarian and curator at the Moorland-Spingarn Research Center as well as her commitments as a consultant on the Black Women's Oral History Project at Radcliffe Institute, and in organizations such as The Association for the Study of African American Life and History, the National Council of Negro Women, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., and the W.E.B. Dubois Research Institute at Harvard University.

General Correspondence documents Wesley's professional activities, including her work with former Howard University president Mordecai Wyatt Johnson, sociologist Adelaide McGuinn Cromwell, John Wesley Blassingame, and authors Charles L. Blockson and Dorothy Sterling. Family Correspondence includes letters to and from Dorothy Porter Wesley as well as third-party subjects. Dorothy Porter Wesley's daughter Constance Porter Uzelac, and husbands James Amos Porter and Charles Harris Wesley are included in this series. Third Party Correspondence includes correspondence collected by Dorothy Porter Wesley during her lifetime.

This series is organized into three sub-series: General Correspondence; Family Correspondence; and Third Party Correspondence. Materials in each subseries are arranged alphabetically by last name and chronologically within folders.

Series III: Research Files, 1847–2004

Research Files consists of clippings, drafts, photostat reprints of letters and notes documenting the research conducted by Dorothy Porter Wesley, Constance Porter Uzelac and Charles Harris Wesley. Materials include research on African, African American, Afro-Caribbean, and Afro-Latino literature and culture used for building the Moorland Spingarn Collection as well as Dorothy Porter Wesley's bibliographies, published books and articles including *Afro-Braziliana: A Working Bibliography* (1978), *Early Negro Writing, 1760-1837* (1971), and *William Cooper Nell, Nineteenth-Century African American Abolitionist, Historian, Integrationist: Selected Writings 1832-1874* (2002). Articles on Sarah Parker Remond, Charles Lenox Remond and their families written by Dorothy Porter Wesley are also included. Dorothy Porter Wesley's second husband, historian and author Charles Harris Wesley's notes and drafts for *William Cooper Nell, Nineteenth-Century African American Abolitionist, Historian, Integrationist: Selected Writings 1832-1874* (2002), are also contained in the series. Other writings include notes and illustrations by Constance Porter Uzelac who completed the bibliography on *William Cooper Nell, Nineteenth-Century African American Abolitionist, Historian, Integrationist: Selected Writings 1832-1874* (2002) in 2002. The series also contains clippings, correspondence and writings on Alain Leroy Locke, professor at Howard University, as well as the correspondence and catalog books of Arthur Barnette Spingarn, who collected African American books, newspapers and manuscripts and whose collection formed the basis of the Moorland Spingarn Collection at Howard University.

Research Files is organized into five subseries: African Literature and Culture; African American Literature and Culture; Caribbean and South American Literature and Culture; Remond Family research; and William Cooper Nell research.

Series IV: Personal Papers

Personal Papers includes photographs, financial documents and ephemera belonging to Dorothy Porter Wesley, Constance Porter Uzelac, James Amos Porter, Charles Harris Wesley, and other extended family members. Dorothy Porter Wesley received personal items from her parents and siblings upon their deaths including tennis records, a memoir and records documenting the tennis career of Wesley's mother, Roberta (Bertha) Ball Burnett, and deeds and journals from her sisters Leonie Burnett Harper and Alice Taylor. Other items include original commencement records from Howard University School of Medicine and Lincoln University respectively belonging to Wesley's father Hayes Joseph Burnett and brother Hayes Burnett II. Wesley was also a beneficiary of the estate belonging to Lula V. Allan and Bertha Allan, who were librarians, teachers and mentors to Wesley at Miner Normal School. The materials belonging to Lula and Bertha Allan include third party correspondence, wills, photographs and ephemera.

Personal Papers is organized into five subseries: General Personal Papers belonging to Dorothy Porter Wesley; Financial records; Ephemera; Family Papers; and Lula and Bertha Allan papers.
